Interfaith Sanctuary - Emergency shelter that offers services to a wide sector of those experiencing homelessness including two-parent intact families, single father families, and single mother families with a male child over age 12 who are not eligible for emergency shelter services at any other location in Boise. <https://interfaithsanctuary.org/>

Boise Rescue Mission - Faith based shelter that provides homeless services to the men, women, and children of Boise, Nampa, and surrounding areas from six unique locations in Ada and Canyon counties. <https://boiserm.org/>

Salvation Army Nampa Shelter - The Salvation Army of Nampa's Kids First Family Shelter provides a safe and warm environment for families experiencing homelessness.
